Re: HOLDING DISCUSSION WITH AIBRF

We request reference to our letter No. 2016/436 dated 28.05.2016 inviting your attention on communication of another retiree organisation, CBPRO claiming holding discussion with the team of officials of IBA on 26.05.2016 and requesting IBA to call AIBRF too for discussion on pending issues.

2. Our above letter was sent to you on mail as well as,subsequently, delivered in your office by our Deputy General Secretary, Shri Ashok Patil and other office bearers. At that time, it was assured that IBA would clarify the position in this regard and would give response to our letter. We have yet to receive the reply.

3. In the meantime, we find that CBPRO has come out with another circular no 006/2016 dated 30.05.2016 (already forwarded to you on mail and also handed over its copy by Shri Patil) indicating that there was very comprehensive and detailed discussion with the officials of IBA.

4. In this connection, we wish to invite your kind attention on your letter no. HR&IR/KSC/GS/2347 dated 28.03.2016 and your letter no. HR&IR/KU/G5/37 dated 7.04.2016 addressed to AIBRF wherein it is stated "in the absence of specific mandate from member banks to hold discussion with the representatives of Retiree Federation/ Association, IBA is unable to hold discussion with your federation to resolve the issues raised by you." Further , we also request you to refer letter no HR&IR/KSC/GOVT/85/63 dated 13.04.2013 written by IBA, Chairman to Dr. Natchippan, Chairman, Parliamentary Committee on Personnel, Public Grievances, Law & Justice wherein IBA has taken the similar stand on holding the discussion with the retiree organisations.

5. But now it seems that IBA has modified and changed its stand on holding discussion with the retiree organisation than what is stated in the above referred communications, in case the facts mentioned in the above referred circular of CBPRO are true. As stated earlier, we welcome this move of IBA. Considering the importance of the matter, in particular the stand communicated to the Chairman, Parliamentary Committee by IBA Chairman on the subject, we feel it is absolutely necessary for IBA to clarify its stand to remove confusion in the matter to all concerned.

6. We also lodge our protest to IBA action of singling out AIBRF and holding discussion selectively with another retiree organisation. At this stage, we would like to invite your attention on the following facts:

- (a) AIBRF is apex level organisation of bank retirees representing about 1.5 lakhs retirees with 44 bank wise affiliates.**
- (b) AIBRF is registered under Trade Union Act, 1926 with due verification of the facts stated above by the competent authority under law.**
- (c) AIBRF is on agitational path on this issue for last one year which is in full knowledge of IBA and its officials.**
- (d) During the month of May, 2016, AIBRF, its affiliates and primary membership have submitted more than 15000 on line representations to the Prime Minister of India on the issue which are under consideration of PMO.**
- (e) AIBRF and its affiliates have submitted memorandum on pending issues of retirees to 3 Honourable Central Ministers and about 30 honourable Members of Parliament during May, 2016. This fact has been brought to the knowledge of IBA and its officials.**
- (f) All the above Honourable Central Ministers and Members of Parliament while accepting the Memorandum from AIBRF delegations have favourably endorsed our stand and has assured to take up retiree issues with the concerned authorities for early solution.**
- (g) In fact many Members of Parliament Members have already written letters to PM/ FM in the matter with copy to us. Prof. P.J.Kurien , Deputy, Chairman, Rajya Sabha in his letter dated 26.05.2016 addressed to FM requesting him to ask IBA to hold discussion with AIBRF. These facts are also in the knowledge of IBA**

(h) More than 15000 bank retirees have come on the streets at 42 cities in the country on 25.05.2016 in support of their pending demands including demand of holding discussion with IBA. Participants included senior citizens, super citizens. This fact is also in the knowledge of IBA and its officials.

We are surprised to note that IBA is simply ignoring wishes and sentiments of lakhs of retirees, central ministers and Members of Parliament and Parliamentary Committee by not accepting the request of AIBRF holding discussion with it on one side and selectively holding with another retiree organisation.

8. We once again request IBA to consider AIBRF request favourably and clarify the position in this regard at the earliest.
