RE: RUMOURS

We find that for last 8/10days news is getting widely spread that some pending issues of the retirees in particular 100 percent dearness allowance and improvement in family pension will be approved in the meeting of Management Committee of IBA held on 24.06.2016, through whattsapp , SMS and e-mails raising hopes followed by frustration and disappointment among the rank and file.

It is observed that our own activists add to such rumours without due verification and knowing source of information by further circulating such messages, possibly unknowingly and unconsciously among the membership. We find that one of our affiliates went to the extent of circulating the message that we should be ready to welcome the decision at the end of IBA meeting on 24.06,2016.

3. We may clarify that AIBRF is keeping total watch on the developments taking place on pending issues of retirees at all fronts. At this stage, we can say that our issues are progressing for solution because of pressure being created by AIBRF through continuous struggle / action programmes. However it may be stated that as per our information retiree issues were not on formal agenda in the Management Committee of IBA of 24.06.2016.

It is seen that some individuals are very active on social media on retiree issues writing with huge negativity and in unrestrained manner and thereby making attempt to create doubts and confusion about the effectiveness of organisational efforts and discipline in resolving the pending issues. Of course, AIBRF cannot join the debate every time with individuals, we appeal to the membership and bank retirees at large to judge whether organisational efforts would ensure resolution of the issues or rumours / individual comments.

5. We assure you that we shall keep you update on all the developments through our circulars/communications from time to time.
