Comrades, you will kindly agree that we have been able to put enough pressure on IBA/ authorities through our earlier action programmes and that they have started responding to our communications. We consider it as beginning of final success of the retiree community under the banner of AIBRF. We feel that stand of IBA/ bank managements on Mandate is simply technical excuse to delay holding discussion with us for resolution. We are confident that with our further struggle and unity of the retirees we shall be able to resolve this technical point very soon.
