They have all signed the memorandum containing the demands made by AIBRF to the IBA. The entire area looked like a ocean brimming with people.

Leaders of ANDHRA PRADESH AND TENGALA STATE BANK RETIREES' FEDERATION (APBRF) affiliated to All India Bank Retirees' Federation (AIBRF) requested the members to silently walk to the entrance of the Bank (as it is working time for the Bank) without hindering the mobility of the vehicles and working employees of the Bank. The APBRF representatives under the leadership of President Sri Rajendra Prasad and General Secretary, Y V Subba Rao proceeded to meet the MD & CEO of Andhra Bank to hand over the memorandum.
