Re: 6th Triennial Conference at Bangalore

We are happy to inform that preparation for 6th Triennial Conference scheduled to be held in Bangalore from 25th to 27th February, 2023 is on full swing. Entire team of Karnataka State Committee is taking all steps to organize logistic arrangements to make stay of delegates, observers, guests comfortable and they are eagerly waiting to extend very warm welcome to you.

2. As per provisions of AIBRF constitution and on the basis of membership position from 34 affiliates covering 41 banks , total **1016 Delegates and 342 observers** are eligible to attend the business session. We expect gathering of 3000 to 3500 persons in Open Session. We are happy to find that we are getting overwhelming response from affiliates for participation in the conference. More than 1150 delegates and observers have already confirmed their participation in the conference along with remittance of required registration fee. We expect confirmation from the remaining in next 10 to 15 days. **In nut shell, Bangalore Conference is going to be very impressive and grand show of bank retirees.**

3. To make the conference highly effective and meaningful where we expect the delegate session to deliberate and take decisions and to draw future road map on retiree issues, we seek support and cooperation from our affiliates on the following points.

(a) General Secretary Report to be presented in General Council is under preparation at Central Office covering all aspects on bank retiree issues in particular. Draft of the report is expected to be ready by 3rd week of December,2022. Thereafter it will be placed before Office Bearers' Committee seeking their suggestions and also seeking their confirmation on it. For this purpose, **it is decided to hold two-day office bearers' committee meeting through video conferencing in last week of December,2022 or first week of January,2023. Exact dates of the meeting will be communicated in due course.**

(b) Thereafter, GS Report will be placed in the Central Committee meeting scheduled to be held in Bangalore on 24.02.23 to seek the confirmation on GS report.

(c) Then, it will be placed in business session of General Council for deliberation and adoption. Total time available to complete agenda of the meeting is 12 hours (720 minutes.) **Out of this, about 7 hours (420 minutes) are proposed to be allocated for discussion and deliberations on GS Report by delegates and observers.** It will be our endure to ensure that maximum delegates and observers are given chance to speak on GS report through strict time management. We seek cooperation and support of all concern in this regard to make the conference grand success.

4. Resolution: As per tradition in AIBRF, resolution on current issues concerning to retirees, social issues, senior citizens and of national importance will be moved in the business session for adoption after discussion on them. We have constituted committee under convenorship of Shri. N.S.N. Reddy, General Secretary,



Our affiliates, Office Bearers, Central Committee Members and activists who have reading, pictorial material on AIBRF, Retiree issues etc. are requested to send the material to Karnataka State committee or Central Office to extend their support for organizing the exhibition successfully.
