Re: Nationwide Submission of Memorandum to Members of Parliament – Action Plan for Pension Updation

You are aware that AIBRF has been conducting sustained and peaceful action programs across the country in pursuit of the long-pending demand of **Pension Updation** and other related issues, including structured dialogue with authorities on retirees' concerns.

As part of this nationwide campaign:

- Dharna programs have been organised in more than 25 cities.
- There has been encouraging participation of retirees.
- Memoranda have been submitted to concerned authorities.
- The issue has received media visibility at various centers.

These collective efforts have strengthened the moral and organizational position of AIBRF.

Next Phase: Parliamentary Intervention Initiative

In order to give further momentum to our campaign, it has now been decided to approach Hon'ble Members of Parliament of both Houses — Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha — by submitting a formal Memorandum seeking their intervention to raise the issue of Pension Updation during the forthcoming Session of Parliament commencing from **09.03.2026**.

A draft of the Memorandum to be submitted to MPs is enclosed for uniform use across the country.

Action Instructions to State Committees

1. **Identify and contact maximum possible MPs** (Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha) from your respective State/Region, irrespective of political affiliation.
2. **Seek prior appointment** and personally submit the Memorandum, explaining briefly:
 - The structural disparity in pension,
 - The humanitarian dimension of the issue,
 - The need for Government to initiate dialogue with DFS and IBA,
 - The urgency of raising the matter in the forthcoming Session.
 -
3. **Request MPs specifically to:**
 - Raise Starred/Unstarred Questions,
 - Make Special Mention / Zero Hour submission,
 - Take up the issue with the Ministry of Finance.
4. Where personal meeting is not immediately possible, ensure submission through:
 - Email with acknowledgment,
 - Official office submission with diary number.
5. **Photographs and brief reports** of meetings may be sent to Central Office for consolidation and media use.

Timeline

All units are requested to complete the task of submission of Memorandum **on or before 05.03.2026**, so that Hon'ble MPs may have adequate time to process and table the matter during the Session.

Organizational Importance

This parliamentary outreach initiative is a crucial step in:

- **Elevating Pension Updation to the national policy platform,**
- **Securing political attention across party lines,**
- **Building moral pressure for structured dialogue,**
- **Demonstrating the united voice of bank retirees.**

We request every State Committee to treat this program as **high priority and time-bound**.

Let us collectively ensure maximum coverage and effective follow-up.
