Re: Nomination of Delegates, Observers and Escorts for the 7th Triennial Conference of AIBRF to be held at Indore on 15th, 16th & 17th December, 2026

We invite your kind attention to Circular No. **2026/0165 dated 25.05.2026** whereby notice was issued for convening the **7th Triennial Conference of AIBRF at Indore from 15th to 17th December, 2026.**

In order to facilitate timely preparation of the Conference records, voter list and other arrangements, all affiliates are requested to complete the process of nomination of Delegates and Observers strictly in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution and the guidelines given below.

1. Eligibility for Nomination of Delegates

Article **11(3)(a)** of the AIBRF Constitution provides as under:

"The General Council shall comprise of the delegates elected/selected/nominated by the affiliates of AIBRF in the manner as per the provisions of their respective constitutions on the

basis of one delegate for every block of 150 primary members or major fraction thereof, subject to a minimum of one delegate and a maximum of seventy delegates from one affiliate."

Accordingly, affiliates are requested to comply with the following:

1. Membership declared by the affiliate **as on 31.12.2025** shall be reckoned for determining delegate entitlement.
2. Every affiliate shall be entitled to nominate **a minimum of one and a maximum of seventy delegates**.
3. Delegates shall be entitled to:
 - Participate in all business sessions of the Conference.
 - Vote on all matters placed before the General Council.
 - Exercise voting rights in the election of Office Bearers, if elections are held.
4. The nominated Delegates shall continue to remain members of the General Council until the next Triennial Conference and shall be entitled to participate in any Special General Council Meeting convened during the intervening period.
5. The list of Delegates must reach the Central Office **on or before 15th September, 2026**. Requests received thereafter are liable to be rejected.
6. The list should bear the **joint signatures of the President and General Secretary** of the affiliate.
7. The list shall be sent **only through E-mail** to the Central Office. Lists sent through WhatsApp or any other mode will not be accepted.
8. The list should be furnished in **Excel format** containing the following particulars:
 - Full Name (exactly as appearing in Aadhaar Card)
 - City
 - Mobile Number
 - Aadhaar Number
9. Any alteration, substitution or correction in the list after submission shall be accepted only if communicated by the affiliate under the **joint signatures of the President and General Secretary** for approval by the Central Office.
10. Acceptance of the Delegate list shall be subject to clearance of all dues payable to AIBRF, including:
 - Annual subscription up to the year **2026**, based on membership as on **31.12.2025**, and
 - Struggle Fund contribution.

2. Publication of Delegate List

The following schedule shall be followed:

- **First week of October 2026:** Provisional list of Delegates will be circulated to affiliates and uploaded on the AIBRF website.
- **Last date for objections/corrections: 20th October, 2026.**
- **First week of November 2026:** Corrected list will be circulated.
- The **final list published in the first week of November 2026** shall be treated as the **official voter list** in the event elections are held during the Conference.

3. Nomination of Observers

The Executive Committee has decided that:

1. Every affiliate may nominate **Observers equal to 25% of its Delegate entitlement**, subject to a **minimum of one Observer**.
2. Observers shall be entitled to attend and participate in the Business Sessions of the Conference.
3. Observers shall **not have voting rights** and shall not be eligible to participate in any election process.

4. Escorts / Spouses

1. Delegates and Observers who wish to bring their spouse/escort shall be permitted **on a one-to-one basis**, subject to:
 - Prior intimation to the Host Unit at least **one month before the Conference**, and
 - Payment of the prescribed registration fee in advance.
2. Escorts/Spouses shall be permitted to attend the **Open Session** only.
3. They shall **not be permitted to attend the Business Sessions**.

5. General Instructions

1. Separate identity badges shall be issued for:
 - Delegates
 - Observers
 - Escorts/Spouses
 - Volunteers
2. Wearing the identity badge shall be **compulsory** for entry into the Conference venue during all official programmes.
3. Entry to the **Open Session** shall be free and badges shall not be insisted upon.
4. Entry to the **Business Sessions** shall be strictly regulated by the Volunteers/Security Personnel on production of valid Conference badges.

6. Conclusion

The success of the 7th Triennial Conference depends upon timely completion of all preparatory work. We, therefore, request all affiliates to strictly adhere to the above schedule and instructions and extend their wholehearted cooperation.

We look forward to receiving the Delegate and Observer lists well within the stipulated time.
