Re: Central Committee Meeting at Bhubaneshwar-11 to 13th Nov.25

Re: NEXT PHASE OF ACTION PROGRAMS

As you are aware, one of the important decisions taken at Bhubaneshwar Central Committee meeting by majority votes was to launch next phase of action programs in support of the following demands of the retirees, w.e.f. 20.11.2025

- (a) Updation of Pension as per RBI formula**
- (b) Payment of Ex-Gratia to pensioners from Private Sector Banks**
- (c) Pension to left over retirees**
- (d) Minimum pension should be Rs. 10000/**
- (e) Pension to be reckoned on special allowance payable to those retired from 2012 onwards.**
- (f) Zero GST on Group Insurance policy for retirees**
- (g) L1 procedure to be followed by IBA for Super Top Policy for retirees**
- (h) IBA to create Grievance Redressal Mechanism for retirees at apex level**

2. We are happy to inform that the action program will BE launched from 20.11.2025 as per decision of the central committee by submitting memorandum to the **Honorable Finance Minister, Government of India on Updation of pension and other demands by the central office with copy to the Secretary, DFS, Chairman IBA.** All state committees, affiliates and their state units are requested to forward the memorandum under their covering letter to FM. **Draft of the memorandum will be sent from central office in a day or two.**

3. It was also decided in the central committee meeting that format of action programs will be broadly as under and main attraction will be RELAY HUNGER STRIKE at various centers and Centralized Relay Hunger Strike in Delhi.

Second Phase programs will commence from 20.11.2025

(b) They will be conducted under banner of UFBRO

(c) They are proposed to be conducted in phased manner from November,25 to March,26 covering two sessions of Parliament.

(d) Primary role will be played by State Committee of AIBRF in organizing programs at different centers.

(e) Programs will include- Dharna cum Demonstrations at minimum 3 centers by each state committee, Relay Hunger strike of 8 hours with minimum participation of 200 members to be organised at minimum one center in each state. Centralized Relay strike in Delhi to be organised with the support of Delhi State Committee to be done in batches for 3 to 5 days continuously.

(f) During the action programs, maximum media publicity to be arranged by the organizers.

(g) At the end of each program memorandum on retiree demands will be submitted to the authorities

(h) Major Demands to be raised- Pension Updation and Ex-Gratia payment to Pensioners from Private Sector Banks.

(i) Other Demands to be raised- Special Allowance to be reckoned for computing basic pay for those retired after 2021, Review of ex-gratia, Zero GST on Health insurance for retirees, Pension to left over, minimum pension of Rs. 10000.

(j) Funds will be provided to state committees for organizing programs depending on struggle fund position.

(k) Periodical review of action program

3. Successful Implementation of the action programs as spelt out above need proper planning and detailed home work. All state committees are requested to hold meetings and prepare detailed action plan, in particular for Relay Hunger Strike with suggested dates to central office within **next 15 days so the action program may be finalized.**

4. We are confident that state committees will demonstrate same enthusiasm and support for implementation of the program as shown in the last phase. **We are finalizing details of the financial support from central office for implementation of action programs based on collection received under struggle fund and advise the state committees shortly.**

5. Detailed minutes of Bhubaneshwar CC Meeting are being finalized and will be released shortly.

6. Principle of Perseverance is backbone of AIBRF functioning. We have been able to resolve many important issues of retirees one after another in last 30 years with continuous persuasion and never giving up the issue in adversity. Criticism and opposition -internal and external need to be taken in stride without much concern. We are confident with struggle and, commitment we shall achieve Pension Updation & other issues in coming days.
