We note with dismay and disappointment that Indian Bank Association has failed to take any concrete action to fulfil the assurances given in the Record Note dated on 25.05.2015 on pending demands of the retirees during last one year. It is noted that unions who are also signatories of Record Note have not been able to create pressure during last one year on IBA to meet its commitment. We are of the view that IBA stand for non-completion of cost study to take further action on retiree demands is nothing but lame excuse to keep the retiree demands under carpets for longer period than justified and required. This house is of the view that in present world of advanced technology where complexed calculations can be completed within no time, how IBA can take such long time for collection of data and compile them which started 34 months back in November 2012 when negotiation for last settlement commenced. It is nothing but a delay tactics of IBA for which this house expresses strong resentment.

We also note with displeasure and dissatisfaction that Indian Bank Association is refusing to hold discussion with the representatives of AIBRF which represent more than 1,50,000 bank retirees on their pending demands on the illogical ground of absence of specific Mandate from member banks and multiplicity of retiree organisations. IBA is forum of bank managements and controlled and run by the bank managements. Therefore their stand of mandate is nothing but unacceptable excuse and an attempt to keep the bank retirees who are direct and important stake holders in pension related issues away from discussion. Bank retirees of the country unanimously resolve and commit to struggle and achieve the demand to hold discussion and negotiation.

We all on the occasion of Demand Day on 25.05.2016 unanimously resolve and pledge our fullest support for all types of struggle in coming days till our following demands are met to our satisfaction.

- 2. Improvement of Family pension on the lines of RBI**
- 3. Updation of pension on the formula of Pay Commission**

We may advise that on 14th May 2014 the delegation lead by DGS Shri Ashok Patil submitted the Memorandum to the honourable Member of Parliament (North Mumbai), Shri Gopal Shetty in Mumbai. The M.P was kind enough to forward the memorandum to FM with very quite effective and strong recommendations for necessary action. Copy of the letter is enclosed for your ready reference.

Our Karnataka state body has organised impressive Dharna cum Demonstration programme at Tumkur on 10.05.2016 wherein more than 250 local comrades participated. The gathering was addressed by the General Secretary, Karnataka Unit Shri Vishwanath Naik and leaders from serving union. Memorandum was submitted to the local Member of Parliament, Mudda Hanume Gowda who assured to forward to the FM.
