Re: Registration of AIBRF under Trade Union Act

We wish to advise you that All India Bank Retirees' Federation has since been registered under Trade Union Act by the Competent Authority with registered office at Ahmadabad, Gujarat. Registration number allotted to us for this purpose is G/6601 dated 13.05.2016.

2. Copy of the registration certificate issued by the competent authority is enclosed for your information and record.

3. Whilst on the subject, we wish to invite your kind attention on IBA letter no HR&IR/KSC/GOVT/85/63 dated 13.05.2016 addressed to Shri Natchippan, Honourable Chairman, Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Grievances, Law & Justice wherein it is stated " there is no set prescribed procedure to verify their majority status/ membership details. As such, it is difficult to ascertain to whom to discuss with."

4. In this connection it may be mentioned that AIBRF is the apex level organisation of bank retirees formed in 1995 immediately after implementation of pension scheme in the banking industry. At present we have 44 bank wise affiliates with presence in all 30 states of the country. Primary membership of our affiliates is in the region of 1, 30,000 to 1,35,000 at present. As per the constitution, AIBRF is authorised to deal with pension related issues of bank retirees at all India level. The facts stated above have been comprehensively verified by the competent authority through the statutory records and books of accounts maintained by us as per the procedure prescribed under Trade Union Act, 1926 while granting the registration. We are ready to produce the relevant record for the verification by IBA authorities also, if called upon to satisfy the requirement of the managing committee.

5. As regards another requirement of mandate of member banks to hold discussion with the retiree representatives, we have
