कानपुर। फेडरेशन ऑफ रिटायरिज एसोसिएशन (एफबीआरए) का एक प्रतिनिधिमंडल बुधवार को सांसद सत्यदेव पचौरी से मिला और समस्याओं के निराकरण के लिए ज्ञापन दिया। ज्ञापन में अवगत कराया कि मौजूदा समय में 75,000 लोगों को पारिवारिक पेंशन मिल रही है। महंगाई को देखते हुए पेंशन की राशि कम है। सितम्बर 2020 को 30 फीसद पेंशन बढ़ाने के लिए वित्त मंत्रालय को पत्र भेजा गया है, लेकिन अभी तक पेंशन का अपग्रेडेशन नहीं किया गया है। एफबीआरए के महामंत्री केसी मिश्रा ने बताया कि बैंकों में 1986 से पेंशन योजना बनायी गयी थी जिनको मात्र दो से तीन हजार रुपये प्रतिमाह मिल रहा है। ऐसे पेंशनरों की संख्या अब ढाई हजार के आस पास बची है। लेकिन 1996 के नयी स्कीम से जुड़े पेंशनरों की संख्या 75,000 के आसपास है। उसी आधार पर पेंशन दी जा रही है। जबकि 2004 के बाद होने वाली नियुक्ति में पेंशन का प्रावधान समाप्त कर दिया गया है। प्रतिनिधिमंडल में एमसी गुप्ता, अजय, बाजपेई, वीएस अग्निहोत्री, एसडी शर्मा, अशोक तिवारी, शिव

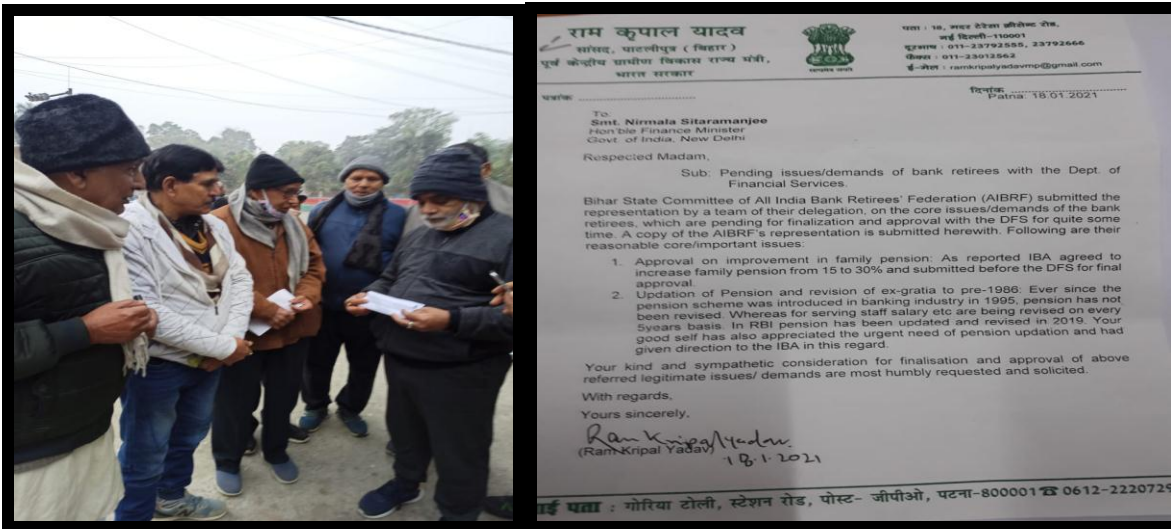
(c) REPORT FROM TELANGANA STATE COMMITTEE

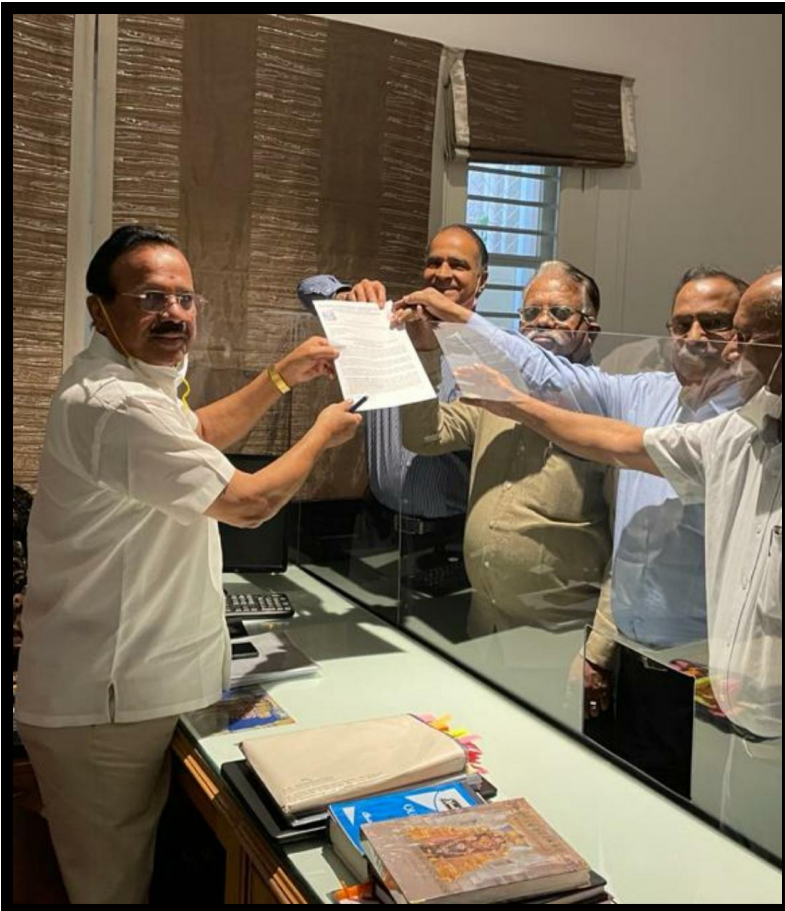
