We request you to kindly refer the above court decision delivered by the Supreme Court, in particular Para 9of the judgement wherein court has directed the concerned banks to make payment of Rs. 2lakhs to the petitioners in full and final settlement of their gratuity claims in view of their advancing age and number of such pensioners is limited.
