**Re: Proceedings of Sub-Committee Meeting Held at Indore
On 28th and 29th April 2013**

The Sub-Committee constituted at Pune Central Committee Meeting had its first meeting at Indore on 28th and 29th April 2013 to take stock of the progress made so far in resolution of the retirees' issues/demands with the special reference to the on- going bipartite negotiation and to formulate strategy/ action plan for the coming days.

The General Secretary gave detailed presentation right from formulation of charter of demands of AIBRF, submission of it to the all constituents of UFBU in delegation and on various demands of retirees included in the charter of demands of UFBU which was finally submitted to IBA and which is likely to become basis for negotiation / discussion in the coming days. The committee expressed satisfaction and happiness on the fact that all the demands listed in AIBRF charter have found place in UFBU charter of demand and believed that it is one significant step forward towards solution of demands and hoped that the UFBU would make all efforts for their solution having secured pension option for left over retirees. However the committee expressed apprehension and concern on the fact that despite repeated request from AIBRF UFBU has not responded positively to invite retiree representatives for consultations and to have effective coordination between two group of stakeholders in the on- going bipartite negotiation. The Committee was of the strong view that there are large number of issues on which immediate consultation are needed and would smoothen the process and eliminate litigation. In view of this the committee decided to continue to make efforts by written communications wherever required and by personal contacts to the UFBU convenor as well as to the leaders of UFBU constituents. The committee would review the position at the appropriate time and take necessary action to protect interest of the retirees in case we fail in our efforts on this count.

The committee also decided to keep close watch on the progress of the negotiation taking place from time to time and would react as per the situation developing.

The General Secretary appraised the other efforts being made at the central office level like meeting DFS officials to draw their attention on our issues and on the adamant and humiliating attitude of IBA towards retirees etc, to ensure the best possible results. The committee also observed that despite AIBRF making all efforts for last 4 years through various channels like

approaching parliamentary committee, contacting directly to the concerned authorities of IBA , writing them periodically in this regard , writing to DFS and meeting its officials personally and using good offices of UFBU to persuade and explain to IBA that retirees are also stake holder in superannuation benefits and IBA must meet retiree representatives and discuss with them for their resolution but without any success so far. This approach of the present team of executives of IBA is unconstitutional .untenable and highly humiliating and insulting for the retirees who happen to be senior citizens. On the one side the government is constituting Senior Citizen Council under the chairmanship of the Prime Minister to address issues of senior citizen and on the other side IBA authorities are showing disrespect to the retirees. Based on these inputs, the committee has decided to launch MASSIVE AGITATIONAL PROGRAMME against the adamant attitude of IBA its present team of executive. It will be in the form of rallies at all the centres where local chapters of IBA are located followed by the submission of the memorandum to the chief of the local chapter of IBA and to the IBA chairman .Main points of the programme are as under

(a) Programme is proposed to be held in the last week of June,2013 or first week of July,2013. The exact date will be decided and communicated shortly after receipt of required feedback/ input from the important centres.

(b) Area wise responsibility of organising the programme will be as under

- (i) S.C.Jain, General Secretary:- M.P., Rajasthan and U.P.
- (ii) Shri S.V. Srinivasan:- Tamilnadu, Kerala, A.P. and Karntaka
- (iii) Shri Debesh Bhattacharya :- West Bengal, Odisha, Bihar and North eastern states
- (iv) Shri R.S.Desai :- Maharashtra and Gujarat
- (v) Shri D.P.Gupta: Delhi and North west states

(c) The above officials will be responsible to coordinate with the office bearers/ central committee members/ activists and contacting the members of the area to ensure maximum presence, contacting sister organisations, union leaders to seek their support and to tie up the necessary logistic at all the centres of the area.

(d) All other details will be provided shortly. The office bearers/ c.c. members are requested to stat to take necessary steps to gear up the programme for successful implementation.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS IS THE PROGRAMME TO BE CARRIED OUT IN THE FOCUSED MANNER TO GIVE CLEAR MESSAGE THAT RETIREES WILL REACT IF THEIR ISSUES ARE NOT RESOLVED AND JUSTICE IS NOT GIVEN TO THEM.

ONE MORE ACHIEVEMENT

We are happy to inform you that the exercise of pension option given to the retirees who took VRS as per the provisions of OSR have been completed in most of the banks and these new pensioners have started receiving monthly pension. We understand that about 6 to 7 thousand retirees have been benefited under this option. The most attractive feature of this option is that without making any payment from the banks contribution on net basis these retirees are now getting monthly pension from Rs. 12000 to Rs. 30000 . This is very significant achievement for us and need to highlighted on the various forums. This could be possible because of legal battle fought by large number of retirees commrades and our state organisations and with support of UFBU.
